

The Importance of Online Reporting – FOR REFEREES!

The Official Record of the Match

The match report and your write up of the match is NCYSA's Official Record of the Match. We rely on your eyes, judgement and neutrality to give us an accurate description of events.

Accuracy Counts!

As NCYSA will use your report to identify those cautioned and/or ejected, accuracy is most important!

We had a great rate of accuracy this past season and hope to see that trend continue!

Be Detailed

Please be detailed in your write up – especially for send-offs. How you view the foul or misconduct could determine if NCYSA considers additional sit outs for the infraction. For example, if you write up an ejection for Violent Conduct, did two players push each other during a stoppage, or did they swing at each other's head with a closed fist?

Only the facts! Everyone gets emotional, but you are our neutral observer! Try to write the report with only facts.

Referee Assault and Referee Abuse

We want to support you and will not stand for Referee Assault or Abuse. If you report either to us, we MUST hold a hearing (according to USSF Policy 531.9) and you, as well as the accused may need to be at that hearing (the accused has the right to face their accuser). Assault and Abuse is serious and we all want to be sure we are doing everything correctly!

Not Just the Bad Stuff!

If you officiate a match and the match goes well – or you particularly enjoyed the experience, write it up as such. Perhaps the two teams fought very hard, but were showed good sportsmanship – let us know that too! We highlight those comments in our newsletter to show that there are teams doing a great job!

Soccer in College Reports

It is important to enter your information – scores and additional comments – in Soccer in College (SiC). We get those report immediately via email. They not only propagate the standings in real time, but we can address any incidents quickly (if needed).

Supplemental Report

As stated above, fill out the Supplemental Report (found on ncsra.org) – and be DETAILED! We also receive those report electronically right away and are helpful in our identifying the AR's as well as other information.
